Cryopreserved New Zealand White Rabbit Hepatocytes

### Animal Information

Tissue was obtained from male New Zealand white rabbits (n=3), approximately 6 months of age. (Covance Research Products Inc., Denver, PA)

Livers were perfused and subjected to collagenase digestion for the purpose of hepatocyte isolation.

## **Assured Minimum Yield:** 5.0 x 10<sup>6</sup> per vial **Viability:** 83.0%

(Yield and viability are based on experiments performed at XenoTech using XenoTech's thawing protocol and Hepatocyte Isolation Kit.)
