Cryopreserved Cynomolgus Monkey Hepatocytes

Animal Information

Tissue was obtained from female Cynomolgus monkeys (n=3), approximately 4 years of age. (Sierra Biomedical, Sparks, NV)

Livers were perfused and subjected to collagenase digestion for the purpose of hepatocyte isolation.

Assured Minimum Yield: 4.0 x 10⁶ per vial **Viability:** 92.0%

(Yield and viability are based on experiments performed at XenoTech using XenoTech's thawing protocol and Hepatocyte Isolation Kit.)

Marker substrate reaction (pmol/cells per inc/min)

7-Ethoxycoumarin O-dealkylation	252 ± 35
7-Hydroxycoumarin glucuronidation	232 ± 59
7-Hydroxycoumarin sulfation	193 ± 43

Store vials in liquid nitrogen, vapor phase.
